



Game: Tic-Tac-Toe Relay

Equipment Needed:

- Tape
- 3 bandannas (red)
- 3 bandannas (blue)

Space:

- Stage space

Set Up: Tape down a Tic-Tac-Toe grid in the middle of the stage. Allow for equal space on either side of the grid for a team on the left and a team on the right.

People Needed:

- Two teams of 3

Objective: Stage game: The first team to get 3 in a row wins!

Game Play:

- Each team is lined up on either side of the Tic-Tac-Toe board.
 - Each team has one color of bandannas.
 - One player from each team runs to the board and lays down one bandanna at a time on the board.
 - Once placed, they run back and tag their next teammate who takes the bandanna and places it trying to get 3 in a row.
 - Both teams are playing at the same time against each other as fast as each team can go.
 - Play continues and players are repeated until one team gets 3 in a row.
 - If play stalls because of a result in “cat” players can remove all bandannas and try again or switch up the players.
