

## Popsicle Stick Picture Frame



### Supplies Needed:

- Jumbo Popsicle sticks (6-7 per camper)
- Hot glue gun
- Construction paper
- Buttons or gems for decoration
- Markers
- Hinge clip
- Adhesive magnet strips (to hang on a fridge)



### Instructions:

1. Give 6-7 popsicle sticks per child.
2. Pre-cut or cut squares that are smaller than the size of the popsicle sticks when aligned together in the shape of a frame. This will serve as the backing of the popsicle sticks for the children to glue them on.
3. Hot glue the square of construction paper to your popsicle sticks – this holds everything together. Have volunteers ready to help with this portion.
4. Flip it over and start decorating it by coloring the popsicle sticks and gluing on buttons, gems, or anything to make your frame unique.
5. Hot glue one side of the hinge clip to top of frame. Have volunteers ready to help with this portion.
6. Hot glue magnets to the back of frame to transform it into a fridge magnet.
