Popsicle Stick Picture Frame

Supplies Needed:

- Jumbo Popsicle sticks (6-7 per camper)
- Hot glue gun
- Construction paper
- Buttons or gems for decoration
- Markers
- Hinge clip
- Adhesive magnet strips (to hang on a fridge)

Instructions:

- 1. Give 6-7 popsicle sticks per child.
- 2. Pre-cut or cut squares that are smaller than the size of the popsicle sticks when aligned together in the shape of a frame. This will serve as the backing of the popsicle sticks for the children to glue them on.
- 3. Hot glue the square of construction paper to your popsicle sticks this holds everything together. Have volunteers ready to help with this portion.
- 4. Flip it over and start decorating it by coloring the popsicle sticks and gluing on buttons, gems, or anything to make your frame unique.
- 5. Hot glue one side of the hinge clip to top of frame. Have volunteers ready to help with this portion.
- 6. Hot glue magnets to the back of frame to transform it into a fridge magnet.
