Shaving Cream Marble Paper

Supplies Needed:

- Shaving Cream
- Food Coloring
- Wood Skewer
- White Card Stock Paper
- Ruler (or something with a straight edge)
- 9×13 Baking Dish or pan sized larger than your paper
- Paper Towels

Instructions:

- 1. Spray enough shaving cream to just cover the bottom of the pan, and then use a spatula or knife to spread it in an even layer.
- 3. Squeeze drops of food coloring on the layer of shaving cream.
- 4. Use a wood skewer to make swirls throughout the shaving cream, making sure to get the desired marbled look. (**Don't over stir your design!**)
- 4. Place a piece of card stock on top of shaving cream and press down.
- 5. Gently lift up and out of shaving cream and place on paper towels with the shaving cream side up.
- 6. Start with one side and scrape shaving cream off in one motion using a ruler. (This is when you'll be able to see the really cool marbling effect!)
- 7. Discard shaving cream and let paper dry completely.
- 8. Place heavy books to flatten paper if it bubbles up after drying.

Related Devotional:

When you dipped your paper in that shaving cream, things got a little messy, right? You swirled your mixture around, maybe even got it all over your hands? But then, you started to scrape away that layer of shaving cream and revealed a beautiful design! That's kind of like what Jesus does with our sin. It reminds me of one of my favorite verses, 2 Corinthians 5:17. When you look at your papers, remember that Christ died to save you from your sins. Through Christ, we are all made new creations! (can share the gospel)
