## Wooden Windchime

## **Supplies Needed:**

- 1 Piece of driftwood or thick stick per person
- Acrylic Craft Tape
- Washi Tape
- Beads
- Yarn/Twine
- Small gold eye hooks (3-5 per person)
- Clear elastic thread or twine
- Scissors

## Instructions:

- 1. Give each crafter a piece of the driftwood or a thicker stick and have them decorate it using the paint or washi tape.
- 2. Add 3-5 eye hooks to the bottom half of the piece of wood. Volunteers may have to get the hook started and then let the children finish it up.
- 3. Place 2 eye hooks on top of the piece of wood, one on either end.
- 4. Tie elastic thread to each hook. .
- 5. String the beads.
- 6. Have campers place beads onto string in whatever order they desire and tie a knot in the end. Tying a bead into the knot will help it stay in place.
- 7. Tie a piece of twine or yarn to the top 2 hooks to serve as a hanger for the windchime. Have volunteers ready to assist younger kids in tying the knots.
