

Painting: Skittle Painting



Supplies needed:

- Bags of skittles, cups of water (1 per camper/ enough for a table to share) , small bowls or cups, paint brushes, printed out pictures, and paper

Instructions:

1. To begin, campers will start by sorting the Skittles by color into the small bowls.
 - a. This is a great opportunity for younger aged campers to work on counting, grouping, comparing, etc.
2. Now, have campers add enough water to each of the dishes to cover the top of the Skittles.
 - a. See Helpful Tips for amount of water to add.
3. Once the water is added, have campers stir or swish the skittles around in the water.
 - a. The color will come right off the skittles and begin to change the water to the color of that skittle.
4. Campers can either choose one of the printout papers to paint or they can choose to freely paint whatever they choose.
5. The paint should be ready to go and Campers are free to take their brushes and begin painting!

Helpful Tips:

- Add enough water to cover the top of the skittles. The more water you add = the paler the color of the paint. The less water you add = the stronger the color
