

Wacky Science: Best Slime Ever!



Supplies Needed:

- Clear or White PVA School Glue, Saline solution, water, baking soda, food coloring/glitter/confetti/other mix-ins, foam shaving cream, styrofoam/paper bowls, measuring cups, measuring spoons, Ziploc bags for storage

Instructions:

- Place a small styrofoam bowl in front of each camper.
- Introduce to the campers that they will be making the BEST Slime ever.
 - a. Ask the campers if they have ever made Slime before and if so, if they knew that there is Science that happens in Slime.
- Each campers will use measuring cups to mix 1/2 cup water and 1/2 cup of glue in their mixing bowl. Mix until the two combine completely.
- Next, campers will choose which fun mix-in (food coloring, glitter, confetti, etc.) they want to add to their Slime!
- Campers will add their fun mix-in to their water-glue mixture, mixing it until it is all combined.
- Campers will then use measuring spoons to stir in 1/4 - 1/2 teaspoons of baking soda.
- Once the baking soda is mixed in, campers will mix in 1 tablespoon of saline solution and stir until the slime forms and pulls away from sides of the bowl.
- Show the campers what kneading is/means. Campers will start kneading their slime. The consistency will change as it is kneaded more and more.
- Store the Slime in small Ziploc bags and write the campers' names on them for them to take home.
