

Connect

- Introduce yourself!
- Ask about their day, favorite moments, or new friends they've made.

Engage

- Review the camper's spiritual assessment tool*
- Ask about the meaning of each image, "What does the heart image mean, etc"
- If they are unsure, explain each significance. Use the 4 Gospel Images as reference points. Clarify any misunderstandings they may have regarding Jesus, sin, forgiveness, or eternal life based on their responses.

Ask

- Ask if they have questions about Jesus from camp or their SAT*
- If their understanding indicates they are ready to accept Jesus as Savior, ask if they wish to make that decision.
- Ask guiding questions like, "Are you ready to accept God's forgiveness and gift of eternal life?" If they say yes, emphasize the significance of their choice, celebrate with them, and guide them in a Salvation prayer.

Celebrate

- Thank them for their conversation today and encourage them to share what accepting Jesus means with a family member.
- *Reminder: SAT is not camper facing language
